# New Videos!

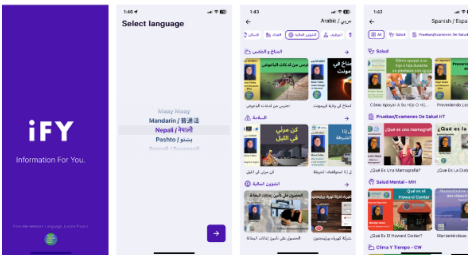
Check out VLJP's new videos about mammograms, pediatric needle pokes, and nighttime safety.

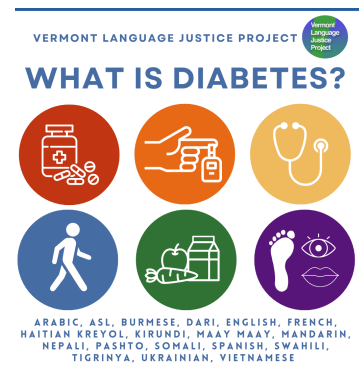
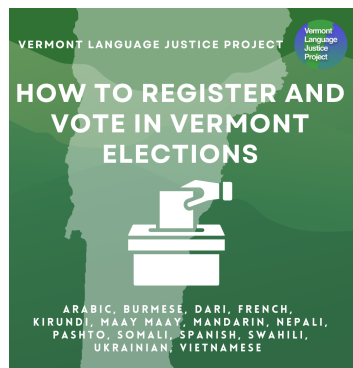


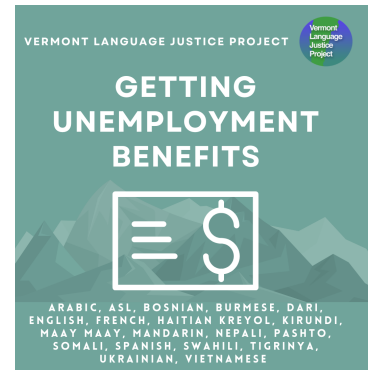
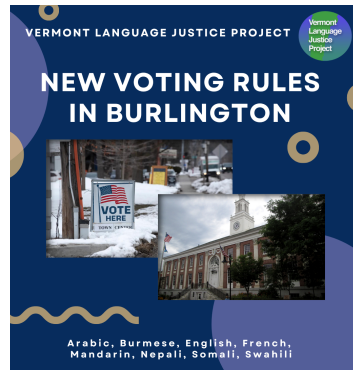
## September 30 is International Translation Day

**OUR IMPACT**

VLJP videos reach marginalized communities to assist their voters, documentarians, and advocates. These guides help voters understand voting procedures, and also serve as a resource for people who speak other languages.

When refugees, asylum, and immigrants arrive in the US, they need to get and use the information quickly in a language they understand. Vermont's guidance and document with Native English speakers in mind, creating significant barriers for people who speak other languages.

VLJP works to bridge the gaps in access and equity by making critical information about health, immigration, and social services available to all Vermonters, regardless of their fluency level or spoken language. By producing and distributing videos in 23 languages, we aim to ensure all Vermonters can make informed decisions about their health and everyday needs. VLJP stands out as one of the few projects in the US creating multilingual videos for refugees and immigrants.

VLJP started in March 2020 to share the voting information about COVID-19 in languages other than English. Since then, the program has responded to the need for expanded video messages in all areas.
