We are excited to inform you that the Vermont Language Justice Project has moved to a new home! VLJP became its own Vermont nonprofit corporation earlier this summer and has applied for tax-exempt status. As that process can take some time, we can now announce that as of October 1<sup>st</sup>, VLJP has partnered with United Ways of Vermont (UWVT) to become VLJP's fiscal sponsor. This will allow us to continue our work under UWVT's tax exempt status while waiting for the IRS decision on our application. Our new collaboration offers an excellent alignment in mission between our two organizations and we are eager to begin this partnership. We thank CCTV for providing us with a solid base to begin our work and develop structures and support to help us on our way.

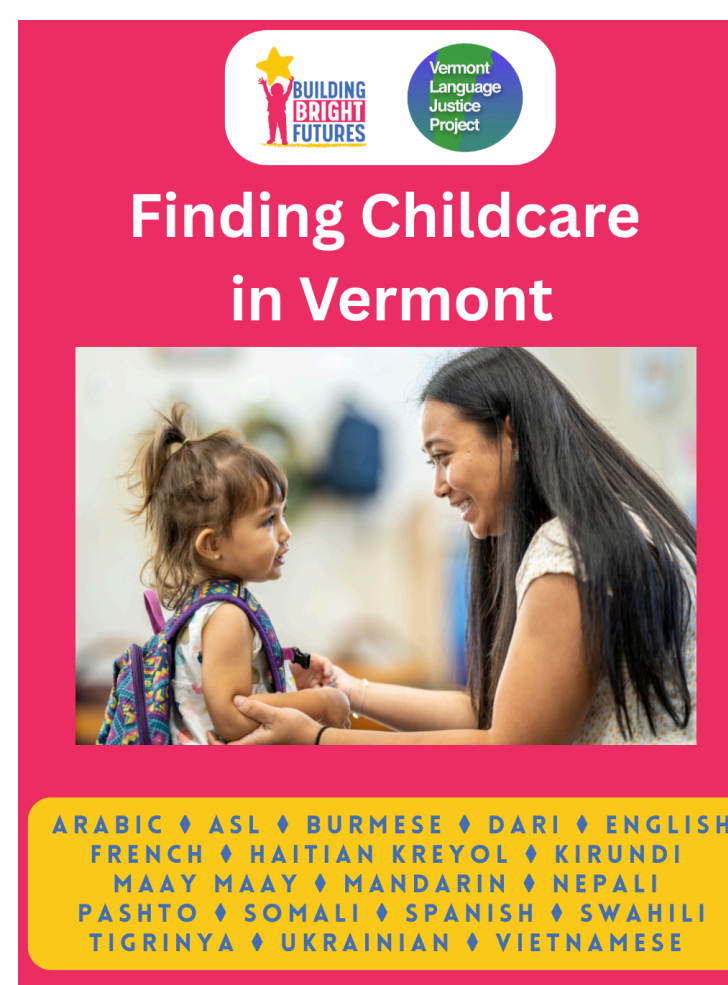

The third in our series on Rights for Migrant Farmworkers and those on H-2A Visas. This one focuses on Housing Rights



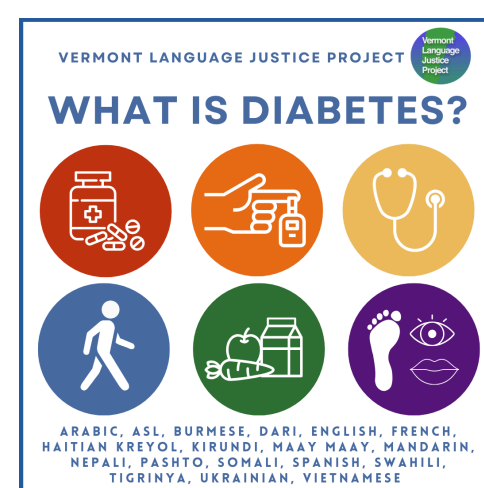
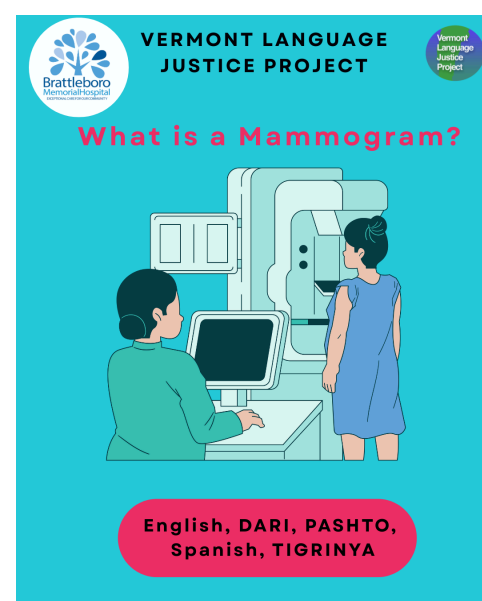
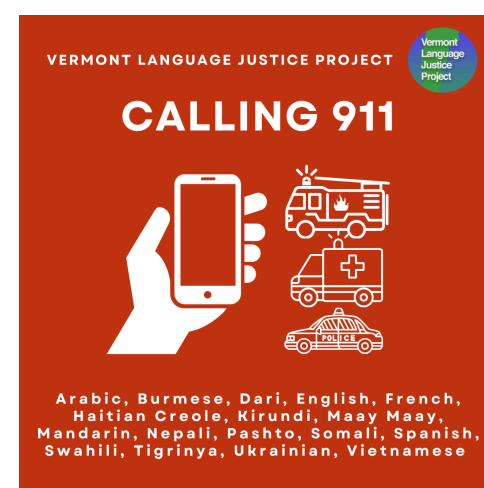
The third in our series on Childcare in Vermont. This video takes you through the maze of looking for childcare and questions you should ask.
